Job Summary

The Short Term Residential Therapeutic Program (STRTP) Clinical Director oversees and provides (as necessary) behaviorally-focused mental health services to children and families with significant mental health issues that impact their ability to transition from the STRTP into a family-based setting. These services, which are child and family focused and strength-based, are provided at the STRTP facility and in the community (including schools, hospitals, and family homes).
